

Dr. Mather discusses the MLB lockout, the implications for minor league and independent professional baseball, and recent school board elections.

Episode 11: "COVID-19 Day 115: Subtyping Senator Tim Scott, Racism, and Police Reform"

5 Minutes, 50 seconds

Dr. Mather briefly discusses the state of COVID-19 studies with children and explains the social psychology behind the reaction to Senator Tim Scott's position as a Black Republican authoring a police

reform bill on a racially charged issue. Subtyping and out-group homogeneity are discussed as concepts. Referenced the recent movies "Created Equal: Clarence Thomas in His Own Words" (2020) and "Uncle Tom: An Oral History of the American Black Conservative" (2020) from Executive Producer Larry Elder.

Episode 10: "COVID-19 Day 100: Propaganda and Trump in Tulsa"

June 20, 2020

6 minutes

Dr. Mather discusses Russian propaganda efforts in the United States during the Cold War. He also discusses President Trump's visit today to Tulsa and COVID-19.

Episode 9: "COVID-19 Day 79: Social Media Regulation and COVID Psychology"

May 29, 2020

10 minutes, 26 seconds

Dr. Mather discusses President Trump's Executive Order regarding social media platforms who censor speech losing liability protections. He also responds to comments and questions from listeners regarding the COVID pandemic.

Episode 8: "COVID-19 Day 72: Data and Polarization"

May 23, 2020

5 minutes, 30 seconds

Dr. Mather reviews the May 22nd COVID-19 data from the world, U.S., and key states. He also discusses the political polarization of responses by liberals and conservatives to the pandemic and the role of the media.

Episode 7: "Government Mind Control"

May 13, 2020

16 minutes, 47 seconds

Dr. Mather continues his discussion of the CIA's MKULTRA Program and gives new information from the 2018 documentary "The Minds of Men." Wilder Penfield, Donald Hebb, Kurt Lewin, Margaret Mead are notably linked to the secretive research program. Research on remote controlled brains of bulls, mammals, and humans is discussed as well as the alleged poisoning of a French village with LSD.

Episode 6: "The CIA's MKULTRA Program"

Dr. Mather discusses the CIA's notorious MKULTRA Program of behavior modification that focused on hypnosis, LSD, interrogations, and erasing memories. He describes the abuses that patients endured in experiments while believing they were being treated for their mental health issues

Episode 5: "COVID-19 Day 44: It's OK to be Angry. We Are Not Collateral Damage"

Dr. Mather discusses how COVID-19 has disrupted employment and the psychological value of work.

Dr. Mather discusses how COVID-19 has disrupted his baseball routines and notes observations on Baseball Tonight Podcasts, vintage World Series games, and local baseball. Discussions of Johnny Bench, the 1975 World Series, and George Brett.

Episode 3: "COVID-19 Day 30"

Dr. Mather discusses the social psychology concepts and research that apply to experiencing a quarantine during the 30th day of the Shelter in Place order of the COVID-19 Pandemic. He discusses data issues on the frontlines of the pandemic as well as some of the nationwide social media fails of video conferencing.

Dr. Mather discusses the fundamental social psychology concepts of attitudes and persuasion. He covers factors of the person sending a message that lead to persuasion, factors of the person receiving a
